Purpose

Take Young members of Kent Scouts and Kent Guide Counties and invited guests into the hills for walking, climbing and scrambling experience in both winter and summer conditions, and to provide opportunities for adults to add Quality Mountain Days (QMD'S) to log books.

Membership conditions

1. The IMC SASU will provide up to four annual events for young members of Kent Scouts to experience Adventurous Activities in Hills and Mountains along with local walks in Kent to promote the Club to possible new members.
2. Any event provided by IMC SASU must be cost neutral to Kent County Scout Council.
3. The IMC SASU, in agreement with the IMC SASU Line Manager, may undertake training towards Assessment of Adults and Young Members and validation of Assessment of Adults and Young Members for Adventurous Activities as part of the annual events. This is to be undertaken by either qualified Assessors who are members of the IMC SASU or qualified Assessors who have been invited to participate in the training events, for the purpose of Assessing Adults or Young Members and have the correct insurance cover, in line with Policy Organisation and Rules (POR).
4. In agreement with the IMC SASU Line Manager, Kent County Scout Council may cover some or all of the cost of Assessors who are undertaking agreed Assessment roles during events in line with Kent County Scout Council agreement on Assessor financial support.
5. The IMC SASU can offer these events to Girl Guides UK to help support the financial side of events and also to support ratio of Walking Group Leaders to Young People and other adults. Events that include Girl Guides will follow Joint Adventurous Activities with Girl Guiding UK.
6. The IMC can offer events in support of the DofE award scheme in agreement with the Kent Scouts DofE appointed Commissioner.

7. The IMC SASU to have its own bank account with a minimum of two IMC SASU members and the Kent County Scout Council Finance Manager as signatories. The Bank account is the responsibility of Kent County Scout Council and the IMC SASU must operate within the guidelines set out by The Scout Association's POR. This includes the IMC SASU accounts forming part of the Kent County Scout Council annual accounts and report. If IMC SASU should become a Joint Guide & Scout Club again this money will remain with IMC.
8. The IMC SASU can set a Club membership fee that is deposited in the IMC SASU bank account for purposes agreed by the IMC SASU members along with the monies already held in the account and any surplus made from an event. If the club is dissolved the balance held in the club's bank and building society accounts after payment of all outstanding bills and expenses, shall be transferred to the Scout and Guide Associations equally.
9. The IMC SASU may hire Kent County Scout Council property, assets and or equipment related to its events at the agreed rates and charges of Kent County Scout Council that are in place and current at the time of the event.
10. All members of the IMC SASU must be appointed or associate members of The UK Scout Association as per POR, have undertaken the Essentials Training Module and have current Safe Guarding and First Response cover as recommended by POR.
11. Any disputes between the IMC SASU and the Kent County Scout Council or its members will be mediated by the IMC SASU Line Manager. Should the dispute be between the club and the CC should be taken to the Regional Commissioner.
12. The County Commissioner (CC) is ultimately responsible for the purpose, objectives and implementation of the IMC SASU Agreement. The CC therefore, has overall authority to make a decision on the purpose, objectives and implementation of the IMC SASU Agreement and any disputes that may arise.
13. This is a living Agreement and subject to change/review.
14. This Agreement will be reviewed by the IMC SASU Line Manager and Manager every twelve months from the anniversary of its inception.
